MAHONING COUNTY ENGINEER PLANS BRIDGE REPLACEMENT ALONG WALKER MILL ROAD IN BOARDMAN TOWNSHIP

Project No. MAH-Walker Mill Road Bridge; PID 111521

March 13, 2023 - The Mahoning County Engineer proposes to replace the Walker Mill Road Bridge (CR 78) over Yellow Creek in Boardman Township, Mahoning County. The project is currently scheduled to begin construction in the spring of 2025. Project details may be requested from this office.

Construction is currently scheduled to begin spring of 2025. During construction, Walker Mill Road at the project site will be closed to traffic for a period not to exceed 180 consecutive calendar days. The official detour route for this closure will utilize South Avenue (CR 151), Western Reserve Road (CR32) and North Lima Road (CR163). See detour map below. Construction and bridge closure/detour information will be posted along Walker Mill Road, along all intersecting side roads and on the Mahoning County Engineer webpage, (<https://www.mahoningcountyoh.gov/188/Engineer>) prior to the start of construction activities. Access shall be maintained to all properties within and adjacent to the project construction limits for the duration of project construction.

While the proposed project will not result in any substantial impacts to environmental resources, Mahoning County Engineer, Patrick T. Ginnetti, P.E., P.S., is seeking any comments you may have regarding the proposed project.
